1. “IRF-Nordic-Baltic Forum for Nature Interpretation” is set up and organized by the IRF-member organizations in the nordic-baltic countries.
2. Each member organization nominates a responsible contact-person.
3. The aim of the forum is:
 - To follow up and implement in the the Nordic Baltic countries the “**11 Shared Principles: Heritage Interpreters promoting sustainable development**” who were adopted at the IRFs World congresses in Australia 2004.
 - Organize exchange of experience and “best practice” within the field of interpretation.
 - Organize Nordic Baltic education- and training courses and seminars - at least a seminar each second year, managed by a new country every time.
 - Organize a Nordic Baltic electronic network concerning interpretation
 - Organize study tours and jobsweb.
